WHAT SEXUAL VIOLENCE IS:

It is considered **SEXUAL VIOLENCE** any behavior of a sexual nature undertaken without the valid consent of both parties, which includes conducts such as indecent exposure, touching, sexually charged remarks and/or violations.

IF YOU THINK A PERSON SUFFERED SEXUAL VIOLENCE OR SEEKS HELP

- Approach him/her. Ask him/her how he/she feels and if he/she needs help.
- Always believe what he/she says and do not make judgements nor do question.
- Do not leave him/her alone, try to create a safe space for him/her.
- Ask him/her what he/she wants to do and respect his/her decision.
- Help him/her contact somebody trustworthy he/she could go with.

WHAT ALL OF US HAVE TO DO

- If you witness a sexual assault, call the Police.
- Take an active role towards sexual assaults: if you witness it do not allow it! Reject and report.
- Coexist with diverse sexual orientations, gender expression and identity in dignity and respect: respect yourself, respect her and respect him!
- Do not allow discriminatory behaviors around you. Sexist jokes, control, jealousy... are harassment.
- Live healthy, free and equal relationships. Not everything is acceptable.
